Most Honourable Princess,

I take the liberty of mailing you again. Only a few days after I mailed you the letter & text I had send to JK Rowling about my book Donkerland ([Don't show, don't tell](#)) a letter of mine got printed in one of the best newspapers in the country (the NRC, in the Science & Education annex dated 5/6-1-2008). I haven't got that translated yet, because an incoming mail of MP Ms. Khadija Arib, Labour, was ever more important (see the attached WORDDOC).

Our Honourable Member of Parliament Ms. K. Arib agreed upon my NRC-statement that a 'brand-new' Child Pornographic Guideline Concerning Prosecuting had some rather weaker points. With the use of my NRC- letter and some other correspondence I had with the Department of Justice she had asked questions to the Minister of Justice on this very Guideline. I can tell you I felt vindicated for being literary neglected: one is suspicious from the start writing on the subject I have written about. Hence the English title, *Don't show, don't tell...*

To shorten this mail: being named (for the only relevant documents number 1 and 2 are 'mine') in the very first question of our honourable MP to this Minister means more to me then a very fine book review. Having said this: I sure could use some help getting this important novel pushed further into focus.
